**10/01/09 Fontmell Brook Issues** The Chairman read a letter from Mr Collin regarding concerns at the possibility of further flooding. Following discussion, during which Mr Highnam explained how the micro-hydro project would fit into the water flow patterns, it was agreed that a telephone list should be produced of the riparian owners along the brook through the village to help the passage of warnings. It was agreed that Wessex Water and the Environment Agency should be invited to attend the next council meeting.

**10/01/10 Other parish matters**

**a. Highways.** The way discussion about the DCC plans to create a voluntary HGV one way system using the C13 / A350. The council agreed to support the scheme but to make it compulsory.

**b. Rights of way.** Work continues with National Trust and Dorset Wildlife Trust to identify a footpath at Longcombe Bottom. An application has been made to change FP12 from a BOAT to a restricted footpath.

**c. Village Hall.** Nothing to report.

**10/01/11 DAPTC matters.** DCC are speaking at a DAPTC meeting on 22 Jan to publicise a business case for the retention of high speed broadband after the Olympics. Details for courses planned for 2010 were issued to members.
