## **Draft Minutes of a Parish Council meeting held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2010 at The School Hall, Fontmell Magna**

**Public Questions.** PC Pearson gave an update on local crime. The following topics were raised: a rumour of house building in the village; the village school micro hydro project; elections to the parish council and the financial implications; First School development plans; smell from drains in West Street; potholes in West St; litter bin in the play park. A request for disclosure of the names of the ten electors who claimed the election was declined as exempt under the FOI.

**10/06/03 Minutes of the AGM.** It was proposed by Cllr King, seconded by Cllr Mills that the minutes of the AGM held on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2010 be accepted and signed. They were signed by the Chairman. **Nem Con**

**10/06/05 Matters arising.** A quotation for repairs to the village pump is still awaited.

**10/06/06 Report from County Councillor.** In the absence of the County Councillor, the Clerk highlighted topics from the report which had been circulated to members. Cllr Campbell reinforced various points on arrival.

**10/06/07 Report from District Councillor.** The Clerk reported that he understood Cllr Kay to be recuperating.

**10/06/08 Update on elections to the parish council.** Following the lack of nominations for the election on 24 June, a new date has been declared as 15 July 2010.

**10/06/09 Development control matters listed on the schedule:**

**10/06/11 Community Shelter.** Following discussion, it was agreed that the requirement had been identified in the parish plan and that a working party comprising the Chairman and Cllr Taylor should investigate possible locations and equipments for a youth / community shelter.

**10/06/12 Other parish matters**

- a. **Highways.** Nothing to report.
- b. **Rights of way.** Cllr Mills reported that, following access to 1962 maps of the area, investigations into the possibility of claiming some paths are being pursued.
- c. **Parish Plan.** Painting of the telephone box at Bedchester was discussed.
- d. **Village Hall.** Nothing to report.

**10/06/13 DAPTC matters.** The Northern area meeting supported the change to the new subscription scheme – this was endorsed by the Exec Committee on 11 June. Useful discussions were held on the participation of parish and town councils within CPEND. The DAPTC Standards roadshows were highlighted. Details of the dates for AGM resolutions have been received.

- a. Ordnance Survey has stated that maps over 40 years old are out of copyright.
- b. The Annual Employers Return has been submitted to HMRC online.
- c. The Dorset AONBs are conducting a survey of fingerposts throughout the county.
- d. The A350/C13 proposals for HGVs have been dropped by DCC.
- e. Blandford Police have reported bogus people offering to lay tarmac. They must be reported.
